If parts are necessary, we can order on select models and will follow up with a scheduled service order.

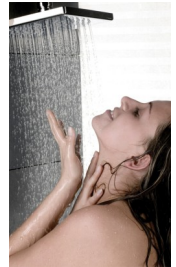

Natural gas appliance—water heaters, cook-tops and ranges, lighting, and generators—will allow you to take care of your family's needs even when the electricity is out. And the more natural gas appliances you have the less power you will require from any back-up generator; because most natural gas appliances can operate without any electricity.

During a hurricane, natural gas appliance shouldn't require anything. Natural gas lines are underground, so there is no need to take any special precautions. In addition, Okaloosa Gas monitors our natural gas system and will shut off the gas if it becomes necessary.

If evacuation is necessary, don't worry about natural gas appliances. When evacuating, it is not necessary to stop natural gas service to indoor appliances before leaving. For outdoor appliances, consider turning off the shut-off valve to the off position while away.

When returning from evacuation, check natural gas appliances first. Check around the house and appliances for the smell of natural gas first. This should be done before attempting to turn on or operate any type of switch or appliances. Natural gas has a very distinctive tart, sulfur odor. If there are concerns regarding these appliances contact Okaloosa gas to make sure that there were no problems while you were away.

Okaloosa Gas Goes Green with a dedicated Natural Gas Vehicle



Recognizing the need for alternative vehicle fuels as an effective solution to help protect the environment and reduce the country's dependence on foreign oil, Okaloosa Gas District has acquired a new natural gas Honda Civic GX .

The Honda Civic GX is a dedicated compressed natural gas (CNG) vehicle, meaning it operates exclusively on clean, efficient natural gas. Compressed natural gas is the cleanest burning alternative transportation fuel and has fewer emissions than any other vehicle fuel being used today.

Natural gas vehicles can improve air quality while reducing our dependence on foreign oil. Okaloosa Gas District service territory covers over 400 square miles in Okaloosa, Santa Rosa, South Walton and Escambia counties. This area includes several military installations which cover over 61 square miles of military reservation.

Okaloosa Gas provides natural gas service to approximately 37,000 residential, commercial, military and industrial customers within this territory.

Natural gas is an environmentally friendly fuel made right here in the United States. More than 80 percent of the natural gas used in the United States is domestically produced – making the country less dependent on foreign oil.

CNG can also be distributed at home with a vehicle refueling appliance, such as the Phill by Fuelmaker. The Phill unit compresses and feeds natural gas from a home's natural gas line directly to the NGV.

According to NGV America, there are more than 120,000 natural gas vehicles on U.S. roads today and more than 7.7 million worldwide.
